For Tutors

What kind of background check do you require?

We require a new background check to be sent directly to Learning Aid Ohio, 510 E. North Broadway, Ste. 401, Columbus, OH 43214.

Please Note: We cannot accept recent BCI background checks from other agencies or with different background check codes.

If you are submitting a BCI background check, use the following code:
5123 081 – Employment with DoDD, County Board of DD, or contracting agency.

If you are not an Ohio resident, you must submit an FBI background check instead.

What documents may I be required to provide?

- Current ODEW license
- BCI
- Drivers License/State ID
- Documentation to support any desired certifications or training listed on your application and profile.

Are tutoring services conducted in person or online?

We are currently only hiring tutors who can provide in-person services.

What will I work on with learners in the program?

This program is designed to provide learners with supplemental learning support for goals listed on their Individual Education Plan. Prior to the provision of paid services, there is an introductory interview where you and the learner can talk through goals with participation and determine if the match is compatible on both sides.

Can I book appointments for clients?

No. Clients must book their own appointments directly through the site to pay for their services with their Learning Aid Ohio grant. It is against our policy for a tutor to schedule appointments on a learner's behalf.

Does Learning Aid Ohio partner with any other businesses or organizations that provide additional educational services?

No. The platform is only available for individual tutors to offer one-on-one services to families.

Can I, as a tutor, offer group services?

No. Learning Aid Ohio grants are for one-on-one sessions between a tutor and an approved learner.
